Happy May Day to everyone!





Claims Corner

We want you to receive as much reimbursement as possible for your claims. Here are some tips for assuring full reimbursement.

Please make sure that the updated enrollment forms are dated correctly. The forms are only good for one year. If a form is dated 4-2014 it will expire on 3-31-2015. The updated form must be dated 4-2015. We are receiving many updated enrollment forms that are dated incorrectly. We cannot go back and reimburse for a previous month if the forms are not dated correctly.

If school is closed for any reason or you have a daycare child staying in your home due to illness or any other reason we must have a note written on the claim or claim information form. Calendars aren't any good for snow day closures, children that are sick, children that are suspended from school, etc.

Internet providers need to mark the school out column to indicate school closures.

Scannable claimers:

Please be sure to **print your name and county** on the first page of your claim, all of the other pages still need your signature. This will ensure that there are no delays when processing your monthly claim!
