Claims Corner

Please take a look at the enrollment forms that parents fill out and make sure that all of the information on the form is accurate. Lots of forms are coming in with missing information (especially the school section if a child is in kindergarten or older). Dating is critical on the forms. We appreciate your help.

Any child who fell into the kindergarten age range and we didn't receive information in answer to our emails or phone calls will be made to be All Day Kindergarten.

Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays are coming up. If you do daycare on these major holidays you need to let us know before you submit your claim by writing a note or putting it in your calendar (internet claimers).

When enrolling an infant we must have the exact name of the infant formula (Similac with iron, Similac Alimentum, etc). There are special formulas (made by Similac, Enfamil & other companies) that require a special diet form to be completed by a doctor so we have to know the exact name to be able to send you forms that you need to claim the infant.
