- If you are OPEN and providing care on a holiday, please mark your KidKare Calendar and/or write a note on your paper claim to let us know you were open. Without some form of notice or documentation, we must deduct meals served on holidays.
- If a move is in your future, there are several steps to take to ensure you continue to receive your food program reimbursement. Contact your licensing agent, your Wildwood program monitor, and the Wildwood office to ensure a smooth transition to your new home.
- Wyoming providers, please send all child enrollment and other forms to the Colorado office listed at the bottom of this newsletter for processing.

### **USDA Nondiscrimination Statement**
